

Rover Journey – 2nd Transition Window

Transition from Rover Progress Scheme 2012

The Rover Progress Scheme 2012 will be valid until **27th May 2017** after which all Rovers will automatically be emplaced onto the Rover Journey. An exception will be made for Rovers who have attained their Pathfinder Award and have been given approval from the NRC to pursue the BPA under RPS 2012.



Rovers can opt for either of the following transition to the Rover Journey depending on the activities they have completed.

A. Tier to Tier Transition

Under this transition, Rovers who have attained the Explorer Award will equate to have attained the Rover Badge on the Rover Journey and should be pursuing the Wayfarer award next. Similarly for the Voyager and Pathfinder for RPS 2012, Rovers will attain the equivalent milestone on the Rover Journey upon transition and can pursue the next milestone.

Should Rovers wish to have a tier-to-tier transition i.e. Voyager from RPS 2012 to Wayfarer on Rover Journey, a **logbook** documenting the attainments of both Explorer and Voyager Award must be submitted to the NRC. Verification will be done by the NRC and successful Rovers will be duly notified.

There will be 2 tier-tier transition window period that will be open for Rovers to submit their RPS 2012 reports for approval by the NRC.

2nd Tier-Tier Transition Window: 20th May 2017 → 27th May 2017

During this Window period, Rovers may hand in their RPS 2012 report for approval. A 2 week period will be given for the NRC to validate and approve the Tier-Tier Transition for Rovers. Should rovers require time extension for submission, a write in must be submitted to nrc@rovers.sg.

Upon successful emplacement, Rovers will also be notified on which modules have been omitted from his/her Rover Journey as these would have already been done during his/her pursuit of the Awards under RPS 2012. This is done to prevent any double-counting of modules. This module omission will be done under the discretion of the NRC and in consultation with the NRAC.



Following 27th May 2017, all Rovers can only transit to the Rover Journey through the Direct Modular Transition Scheme. All decisions made by the Rover Journey Review Committee is final. No appeals will be entertained.

B. Direct Modular Transition

Alternatively, Rovers can switch directly to the Rover Journey. For ease of transition and acknowledgement of prior learning, Rovers can key in modules that they have done since they became a Rover Scout up to the present point, and achieve the respective Milestone for the miles they have attained. This transition will occur till **31st December 2017**.

C. BPA Nominees under RPS 2012

Rovers who have attained the Pathfinder Award by **27th May 2017** may pursue the Baden Powell Award under the RPS 2012 until 2019 BPA nominations. These Rovers will need to register their intent and submit a logbook documenting their Explorer, Voyager and Pathfinder Awards with the NRC through email, nrc@rovers.sg, by the **27th May 2017** should they decide to remain on the old scheme. Should Rovers fail to attain the BPA by the 2019 BPA nominations, they will have to transit to the Rover Journey.
